About

- **DHS is hosting a monthly “office hours” conference call with lead agencies that have launched MnCHOICES.**
- The purpose is to provide an opportunity to stay connected with and support lead agencies as they continue to implement and manage MnCHOICES.
- Lead agencies will have an opportunity to ask questions of DHS staff, as well as provide feedback on MnCHOICES implementation.
- Office hours calls are **not** designed to provide individual technical assistance or troubleshooting. Lead agencies should continue to send questions and issues to the SSIS Help Desk for a timely response. See contact information below.

Participation:

- Any lead agency that has launched MnCHOICES may participate.
- Suggested participants include MnCHOICES Mentors and Administrative Contacts. Other lead agency staff should work through their mentors to ask questions on the conference call.
- DHS recommends each lead agency call-in as a group.
- Participation is optional but strongly encouraged.
