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### [New FAQ about e-health grant RFP](#)

Staff has put together frequently asked questions related to the Minnesota Accountable Health Model e-health Grant Program. This FAQ is geared toward those interested in applying to receive a community collaborative e-health grant. The deadline for sending a letter of intent to respond was March 27. Actual responses are due May 5.

This \$4 million grant program will support the exchange of medical or health-related information between organizations participating in or preparing to participate in accountable care models. One of the goals of the grant program is to support providers in their efforts to exchange health information across settings, such as clinics, hospitals, long-term and post-acute care, behavioral health, local public health, and social services.
