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AUC Approves new TAG for SIM work

Following the recommendations outlined in the Minnesota Accountable Health Model task forces [Data Analytics subgroup](#) phase 1 report, discussions started with the Administrative Uniformity Committee (AUC), to ask if they would assist with the standardization of the first high-priority element, **"Contact Information & Identified Primary Care Provider"**. The AUC is a voluntary, broad based group representing Minnesota health care public and private payers, hospitals, health care providers, and state agencies, working to standardize, streamline, and simplify health care administrative processes. On September 17, the state received notice that the AUC voted to establish a Technical Advisory Group (TAG) who will take up this work.
