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### Practice Facilitation Grant Program

The Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) requests proposals for the Minnesota Accountable Health Model (SIM) Practice Facilitation grant program. Approximately \$1,016,000 is available to fund two to five practice facilitation projects.

The goal of these projects is to support a range of providers and teams in primary care, behavioral health, social services, long term and post-acute care, or accountable care organizations or similar models to allow team members to participate in transformation activities that help remove barriers to care integration.

**An organization's ability to implement practice facilitation services must be demonstrated through the organization's capacity, experience and/or contracted relationships in place.** The staff or contractors must be qualified through experience to do practice facilitation with primary care, behavioral health, social services, long term and post-acute care services, and accountable care organizations or similar models.

Letters of Intent are required and due February 3, 2015 at 4:00 pm CST.

Applications are due March 3, 2015 at 4:00 pm CST.
