Request for Proposals for Practice Transformation Grant Program, Round 3 - Open to Behavioral Health Home First Implementers

The goal of the Practice Transformation Grant Program is to support a range of providers and teams in primary care, behavioral health, and social services to allow team members to participate in transformation activities that advance the goals of patient centered, coordinated, and accountable care.

Practice Transformation supports the broad goals of the [Minnesota Accountable Health Model](#) related to providing Minnesotans with better value in health care through integrated, accountable care using innovative care delivery models that are responsive to local health needs.

\$390,000 is available for implementation of up to 39 grants for \$10,000 per grantee for six months.

Eligible applicants are limited to members of the Behavioral Health Home First Implementers group coordinated through the Department of Human Services preparing for behavioral health home certification.

Applications are due October 15, 2015 at 4:00 pm CDT
