The Minnesota Accountable Health Model has released (or will release) 21 grant RFPs with a maximum of \$19,646,000 in available funding. To date 167 proposals have been received, totaling \$37,021,115 in requested funding. \$17,718,004 in awards have been granted to 112 applicants.
